### Mudguards F148, FT148, FT149 and FT150 in Aluminium and Stainless Steel

#### Adjustment of Radius

Mudguards are either machine or hand rolled to a template and polished after rolling, we have found that after polishing the radius can change also remember there can be variations between different Vincents, eg Series 'B' where the RFM is shorter than the 'C', different stays, chain guards may have been used over the years giving small differences that can add up.

It is quite a simple job to adjust the radius to suit your machine.  
To 'close' the radius pull the side apart every 2 inches (50mm) as below.  
To 'open' push the side together.  
You will need to use quite a bit of effort particularly with the stainless guards, bit do little and often movements.  
After two rounds of pulling the sides apart the radius opened up by 3/4" (20mm) the change to the width of was only about 1/4" (6mm).  
Once in place and bolted down on the bike the sides can be pulled apart if necessary to give a better cross section radius.
